The fees displayed include the costs incurred by RYIF. There will be two receipts issued to the student by RYIF and RYI.

A non-refundable Admission Fee must be paid for all degree programs and non-credit study once you have been accepted into the program and must be made within two weeks of acceptance in order to secure your place in the program.

**The summer program tuition is due in full, two weeks after acceptance into the program. The summer program fee includes a welcome reception and farewell dinner, tuition, lunches at the Utpala café when classes are in session, and day trips within the Kathmandu Valley. The tuition fee for the Buddhist studies summer intensive program also includes all expenses for the guided meditation retreat at the Pharping Monastery at the end of the course.*

***As an integral part of the Tibetan and Nepali colloquial language programs, participants may opt to live with local families that have been carefully selected by the Rangjung Yeshe Institute. This provides students with intensive exposure to the language and a unique opportunity to experience life among people in the local community. The summer program on campus with the homestay option will include the RYI administrative home stay fee. The homestay fee of about \$230 per month is not included; students must pay this in local currency (approximately NPR 30,000) directly to the host family. Students who choose to opt out of this service will need to arrange accommodation and meals on their own.*
